District Governor's Citation

1. The clubs should accumulate a minimum of 100 points by conducting programs and activities indicated under Membership Development, Eradication of Polio, Enhancement of Rotary Public image and different Avenues of Rotary Service to qualify for the Presidential Citation Award.
2. The activities must be attempted in all the categories by achieving a minimum of two activities in each of Categories.
3. Accumulation of points will be done monthly basis, based on the activities undertaken by the clubs and same reflected in the monthly report to reach on the 7th day of each month, to the designated Dist. Secretary copy to DG.
4. The points must be accumulated by clubs between 1st July 2009 and 31st March 2010.
5. The clubs should send their final report on all activities to the office of the Governor on or before 5th April 2010 except the donations made to the Rotary Foundation will be accepted till June 25, 2010.
