

Cricket Rules and Guidelines for Yarana Cup

Apart from the general rules and guidelines of District 3060 sports, the following guidelines are applicable for Cricket in particular.

1. The host team will extend an invitation to the visiting team regarding the Venue and Time, well in advance.
2. The host team will extend the courtesy of Tea, Breakfast and Lunch to visiting Team without charge.
3. If the visiting Team, coming from long distance, reaches the host city, the previous evening then the host team is requested to provide Home Hospitality or free accommodation and Dinner. It will be good fellow ship.
4. It will be the responsibility of the host team to provide for a turf wicket ground with Six Stumps and Bails, & two neutral Umpires, if visiting team wants neutral Umpires they will be if the Chairman is informed at least 4 days in advance. In these circumstances the cost will be shared by both teams.
5. The decision of the Two Umpires will be final and binding to both the Teams.
6. Both the Teams shall play with Season Cricket balls (Match ball).
7. Both the teams shall play with their independent Cricket gears including balls.
8. The Matches will be played in Knock out basis.
9. The matches will be limited to 30 Overs per side. The cricket matches to be played as per One Day International limited cricket rules, except for fielding, where fielders will be allowed to field any position regardless of the number of over in progress, however 9 over Power play can be implemented if both caption willing to do so, in that case only 3 fielders are allowed outside the 30 yard circle up to first 9 over, There will be Free Hit after every front foot No Ball and field cannot be change if the same Batsman remains in Strike. However one can change field placement in Free Hit if the strike is rotate.
10. All the Matches have to start by 8 30 AM with grace period of 30 Minutes, so as to end in time.
11. If a visiting team fails to show up by 11 30 AM on the day of the scheduled Match, the other team will be granted a walk over.
12. If for any reasons the schedule is to be changed by mutual understanding of both the teams, this will be permissible only ones.
13. The score sheet of both the sides have to be signed by both the captions and it will be the responsibility of the wining team caption to send original Score sheets of both sides to The Chairman, District sports the next day of the match.
